

2010 Riversport Slalom Race

August 21-22, 2010
Confluence, PA

Location: Ramcat Rapid, Middle Youghiogheny River, Confluence, PA.

Directions: Find your way to the Lucky Dog Café or Riversport School of Paddling Store on River Road, Confluence, PA (Google Maps, Expedia, etc.) From the Lucky Dog on River Road make a right turn on Rt. 281, cross over bridge over Casselman River and make a left turn at Stop sign on Oden St. Follow Oden street straight across Manning St past Community Center on right and town gazebo/park on left. Arrive at Stop sign with gas station on your right. Make right turn at Stop sign and follow road out over one-lane bridge up to Yield sign. RR tracks on your right. At Yield look down the road for cars as it is a one lane road before proceeding. After road becomes 2 lanes again look for sign for Paddler's Lane on your left. This is right before you cross RR tracks. If you cross the RR tracks you've gone too far. Turn left on Paddler's Lane (gravel road) and proceed slowly. Yield to oncoming cars if possible. You will pass Paddler's Lane B&B on your left (2 buildings and a shed/garage) Immediately after shed/garage turn left at Camping sign, into parking lot for campground. You cannot park on grass in camping area. You may drive to a certain point, unload your car and then park your car in the parking lot.

Accommodations: Camping is available on-site for \$6.00 per person per night on weekends, \$5.00 per person per night on weekdays. Day use fee of \$3.00 for non-campers. Please pay this fee on your entry form. Flush toilets and showers are available, the day use fee helps offset the cost of these. This is a private campground that the owners of Paddler's Lane B&B are allowing us to use as a race site. Please respect their property and rules and clean up after yourself. Paddler's Lane B&B (800-777-6061) is located right next to the race site. Call to see if any space is available. Additional Bed & Breakfasts are scattered throughout the area, check <http://www.visitconfluence.org/> for a listing.

Course: The course will consist of 18-25 gates. It is semi-controlled water so it could be shallow Class II to Class II+ or III if it storms in the days prior. A beginner to easy intermediate course should be expected.

Classes: See the entry form for classes.

Entries: Complete entry form and waiver and send to Riversport SPWT Race Registrar, 384 Lindscot Lane, Wexford, PA 15090. Make checks payable to Natalie Thomas. Each competitor must fill out a separate entry form, i.e. two per tandem boat. Entry forms must be postmarked between July 19, 2010 and August 12, 2010. Late registration will be accepted until 1:00pm at the race site on Saturday, August 21. A late registration fee will be charged on that day. Participation is limited to the first 100 boats properly paid. **Do not mail the entry form after August 12th, bring it with you and register on site.**

Rules: Decked boats will race under the USACK Whitewater Slalom Racing Rules with modifications. Places will be decided based on the better of 2 race runs. Open boats must comply with the boat specifications of the ACA National Whitewater Open Canoe Committee and will race under open canoe rules.

Work Assignments: All competitors will be given work assignments. Failure to complete work assignment will result in disqualification.

Limits: There is a limit of 100 boats for the race, entries to be taken in order received. There is a limit of 2 classes per person.

Eligibility: All competitors must be amateurs by ACA definition, and must also be competent swimmers. The race is restricted to members of the ACA. Nonmembers may purchase a \$5.00 participation membership (for insurance purposes), good only for this race.

State Park Regulations: Ohio State Park is on the far side of the river from the race site. If you need to be on that property (helping with course setup or take-down) please be respectful of park patrons on the bike path, wildlife and vegetation. Pick up all litter you see. (We need a permit to hang gate wires on their trees so please be on your best behavior at all times).

Registration: Look for the registration table to check-in for clinics, verify that your registration was received and complete or late register. Registration closes at 1:00pm Saturday, August 21. Registrations will not be accepted on Sunday morning!

Schedule: *Friday:* Hang the gate wires and course. The course will be closed until completed.
Saturday morning: Finish hanging the course (if necessary). Practice runs may be taken after the course is complete. Late Registration and check-in from 9:00 am to 1:00 pm.
Saturday afternoon: 1:00pm – 3:00pm Slalom clinic. Course is closed to all except clinic participants. Practice runs can be taken after the clinic is over.
Sunday: Competitors meeting at 8:30 am. Race starts at 9:00am. Course takedown is immediately after the race, followed by awards.
